- ① Sleeping gym near the fields!: Wirtschaftshauptschule Baden, Pelzgasse 13
- ① Playing fields: Thermalstrandbad Baden, Helenenstraße 19-21
- ① Dinner: Gasthof Martinek, Jägerhausgasse 7 (5 min walk from Strandbad)
- ① Saturday party: Starting at 10 pm in the Billardcafé Esplanade, Helenenstraße 40 (marked as 'Come together' on the map)  
**IMPORTANT: Please don't bring** your own beverages to the Café Esplanade, it's a Pub and let say the innkeeper would not be amused about it.  
Please take care of the billiard table for avoiding damages, don't use them for sitting or putting your beverages on there.

### **Some important information**

- **sleeping gym - opening hours**
  - Fri from 9 pm
  - Sat we will lock up the gym during the day, please leave the gym till 9:30 am available again from 6 pm – 8 pm and again from 11pm
  - Sun please leave the gym till 9:30 am (take all your stuff to the fields)
- **please note**: the sleeping gym is pretty close to the fields, breakfast, dinner and evening-program. As this gym is in a living area and we would like to use it next year again, we were told especially to be quiet on the way to and near the gym. So please help us in this matter.
- **IMPORTANT: PLEASE THROW DISCS ONLY IN THE GYM!** We had some damages the last 2 year at the walls caused by disc hits so we had to pay the restoration of the painting.
- there are **hot showers at the fields - use them!**
- **please bring** your own cutlery, plates, cups and water-bottle (tap water in Baden has excellent drinking quality!)
- don't forget your **SWIMSUIT** - they will most probably open the swimming pool for us 😊
- **food & drinks**: there is a café at the Strandbad + a small bar (run by SPIN) near the fields where you can get low-priced drinks and cocktails
- **NOT ALLOWED** in the whole area of the Strandbad Baden: GLASS BOTTLES and DOGS
- It is possible to leave (sports-)stuff at the fields
- As there will be viewers and strangers **PLEASE TAKE CARE OF YOUR STUFF!** Especially of your valuables and discs

**A BIG REQUEST: THE GYM, THE FIELDS, DINNER- and EVENING-LOCATION ARE SITUATED IN A LIVING AREA. PLEASE AVOID NOISE ON THE STREET, ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT. WE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE SANDSPLASH NEXT YEAR AGAIN.**

## Program

### **General registration info:**

### **Spirit rating system**

"a day at the beach", already seen at Sandsplash the last years (will be explained at the captains meeting)

### **Rules and games**

The 2009 WFDF Ultimate rules will be in effect.

Please keep in mind that, if confusion arises in a hot game, each debate should be guided by the **Spirit of the Game**, and all players should strive to resolve disagreements in mutual respect and a friendly atmosphere.

## Rules:

**SANDSPASH is a mixed-tournament**, 5 vs. 5 players. This means you need a minimum of 3 men and 3 women in your team. Every point is played with 2-3 women/men on the line depending on the offence. If a team cannot provide this, teams shall play their game, but the score will be 7-0 (guess who wins).

There are 4 pools of 4 teams each. In the first round teams play round robin in each pool.

Tie breakers (pool games): being contrary to what the HP says, if teams are tied and we count point differentials or scored points, we only count the points from the games of the respective teams against each other.

Second round - 1st and 2nd placed teams of Pools A and D form upper Pool 1 (UP1), 1st and 2nd placed teams of Pools B and C form upper pool 2 (UP2), 3rd and 4th placed teams of Pools A and D form lower pool 1 (LP1), and 3rd and 4th placed teams of Pools B and C - lower pool 2 (LP2). Teams play round robin in each pool, the result of first round games will count also in second round.

Third round (cross games) - 1st placed team of each upper pool plays against the 2nd of the other upper pool; 1st placed team of each lower pool plays against the 2nd of the other lower pool. 3rd placed and 4th placed teams play respectively.

Playoffs (games for places) - winner-teams of cross games play for, respectively, 1st, 5th and 9th and 13th place, loser teams - for 3rd, 7th and 11th and 15th place.

If teams are tied after the pool games, following rules will be applied:

1. head-to-head game;
2. (head-to-head game ended tied) point differentials;
3. (head-to-head game ended tied, point differentials are the same) number of points scored (in all games);
4. (head-to-head game ended tied, point differentials are the same, number of points scored is the same) drawing lots.

All games last 30 minutes. There is no point cap, except in games for places. When the time is over, the point has to be finished (point starts as soon as a point has been scored).

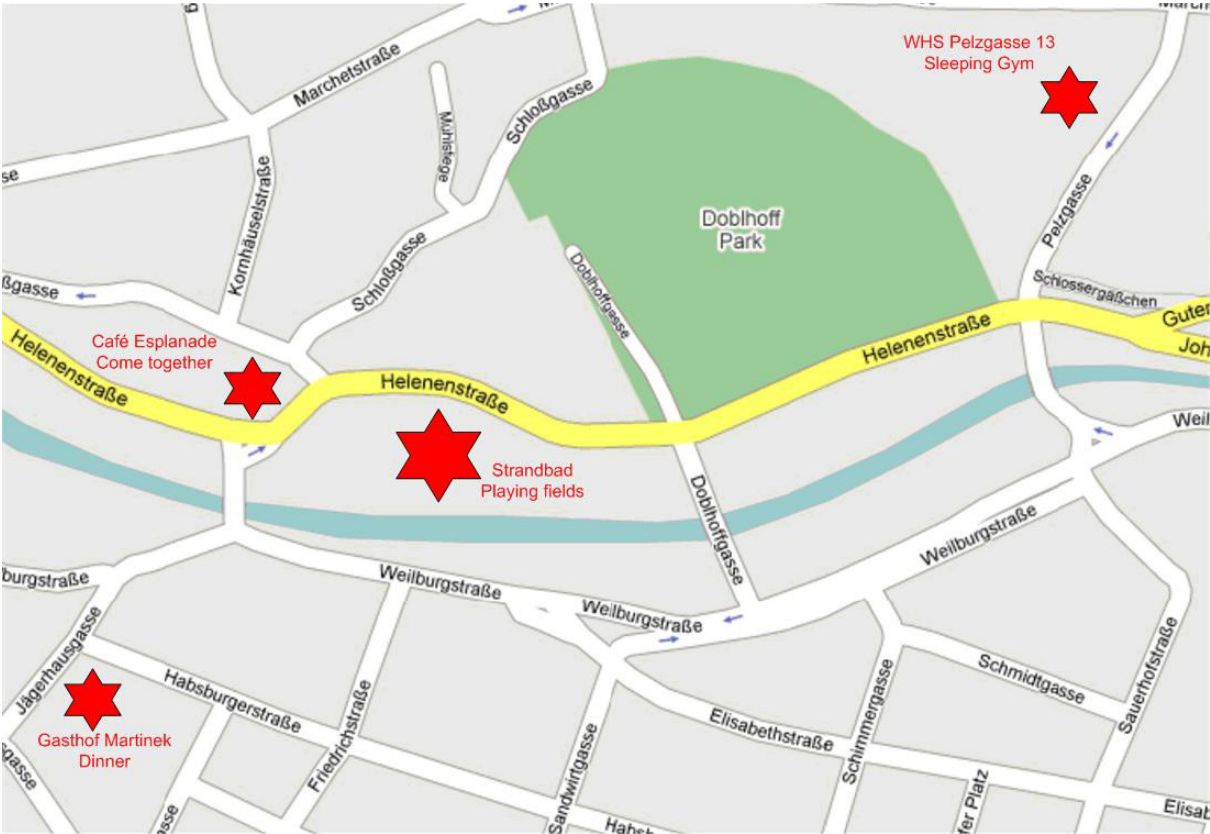
1st and 2nd round games: When time is over, the point has to be finished and NO extra point is played. A draw is possible! (Evaluation: 2 points for victory, 1 point for a draw).

Cross games: a draw is NOT possible! IN CASE of a draw one extra point has to be played. (i.e. time is over -> point has to be finished -> score is a draw (e.g. 8:8) -> an extra point has to be played).

Games for places (incl. final): when time is over, the current point is finished and 1 point added to the highest score, thus determining the point cap of the game.

- **1 timeout (1 minute) per team**, not to be taken in the last 5 minutes.
- **Stall count is 10 seconds.**
- **Brick rule** applies (brick point 3 m up the field from the endzone line).
